

**High Desert Quail Forever  
2013 Projects to Date**

**February**     **A-41** (Hwy 247, Lucerne Valley)

Replaced 650 gallon fiberglass tank with a 2300 gallon SCBS Rain Catcher Big Game System, cleaned and patched apron, repaired fence, build new Johnson Screen catch basin and installed 40 lf of 4” water pipe to the tank. 650 gallon small game tank is being reconditioned for placement elsewhere.

**March**        **A-63** (Johnson Valley)

Cleaned, patched and repaired fiberglass tank, chipped and patched apron, installed new fence, built up apron curbs to help direct water in to the tank. Saturday crew wired the fence, installed signs and treated the apron with self-leveling mortar to even surface and fill cracks. Apron sealed. This sytem had been out of service since 2006 and is now restored to full capability.

**A-43** (Lucerne Valley)

Chipped and patched apron, repaired fencing, installed signage and repaired (temporary) tank lid.

**April**         **A-62** (Johnson Valley)

Cleaned 1 yard of debris from tank, replaced tank lid, installed fence and signage, patched fiberglass tank, patched, sealed apron. This system had been completely out of service since 2005.

**May**            **A-64** (Johnson Valley)

Complete rebuild and seal of apron, lid, fence, curbs, turtle ramp, signs. Patched fiberglass Tank.Out of service since 2005. .

**A-44 (Lucerne Valley)**

Drained, cleaned and patched fiberglass tank. Replaced old fence wire with new slick wire, installed signs, chipped and patched arpon cracks, built up and repaired curb. Refilled with 550 gallons of clean water.

**June**           **A-107 (Lucerne Valley)**

Drained and cleaned tank, repaired welded seam in wall of steel tank that was leaking.
